

## Limerick Flying Club COVID-19 Mitigation

In line with current HSE recommendations the Limerick Flying Club continues to take all reasonable precautions to prevent the spread of Coronavirus while still having aircraft available to members subject to some restrictions.

1. All DUAL instruction including all voucher and introductory flights have been cancelled
2. Any PPLs who are current on the club aircraft can continue to use club aircraft but are subject to the following additional operational requirements
3. A current PPL can bring a guest but MUST complete the attached questionnaire BEFORE the flight and leave the completed document in the club.

These restrictions are subject to constant review by the CFI, instructor panel and committee and any updates will be communicated to all members.

1. If you are displaying flu like symptoms however mild then please do not come to the airfield until you have fully recovered and the recommended self-isolation period is complete
2. If you have been outside the country or are in close contact with someone who has, then again please do not come to the airfield until after the recommended self-isolation period
3. In general please comply with all personal hygiene recommendations
  - a. Wash your hands properly and regularly
  - b. Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve when you cough and sneeze
  - c. Put used tissues into a bin and wash your hands.
  - d. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces, particularly shared work spaces, aircraft, toilets, shared keyboards and counter tops in the OPS room

As well as the above the following additional operational requirements are now in place and all members are expected to comply with these instructions until further notice

### On arrival and prior to flight

1. Following standard aircraft inspection wash your hands
2. Using the supplied antiseptic wipes, wipe down all aircraft controls and switches
3. If using a club headset use a new antiseptic wipe to clean all headset surfaces
4. Dispose of any used wipes or tissues in waste bin
5. Wash hands

### During flight

1. Practice normal personal hygiene standards including covering your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve when you cough and sneeze

### On completion of flight

1. Again using supplied antiseptic wipes, wipe down all controls and switches
2. If using a club headset use a new antiseptic wipe to clean all headset surfaces
3. Dispose of all used wipes and all tissues in waste bin
- 4. Do not leave any tissues, wipes or other rubbish in the aircraft**
5. Return aircraft to hanger
6. Wash hands
